DECISION – ON PAPERS

This is an application by North Otago Scottish Society for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 10 Tyne Street South Hill Oamaru 9400 known as “**North Otago Scottish Hall**”.

Reports have been received from The Waitaki District Council Licensing Inspector, The New Zealand Police and The Medical Officer of Health.

Based on the information provided to us on the complete file, we have determined to grant the application on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act. We grant the applicant a special licence pursuant to s.22 of the Act.

The licence is approved and will be subject to the following conditions:

Section 147 (3) - Compulsory conditions

- (a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
- **Saturday 20 July 2024 from 7.30pm to 11.30pm**
- (b) Drinking water must be freely available on the premises from the water station in the hall and from the bar.

Section 147 (1) - Discretionary conditions

- a) The licence holder must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- b) Food must be available for consumption on the premises as specified: Neeps and Tatties, haggis, salads, cranachan, shortbread, cheese and fruit platters, breads and crackers and dips must be available for all attending.
- c) Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises at all times alcohol is being sold or supplied throughout the event.
- d) Non-alcoholic beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises as specified in the application.
- e) The licensee must provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises. A courtesy vehicle must be provided, a free phone and the name and phone numbers of the local taxi companies must be clearly displayed.

- f) A copy of this licence, together with signs showing the age restriction must be clearly displayed.
- g) Members of the public must be excluded from the premises in the following circumstances:
Entry is restricted to ticket holders only.
- h) Only the following kind or kinds of alcohol may be sold on the premises: Beer, wine, and cider.

The licence is also subject to the following conditions, which in the committee's opinion are not inconsistent with the Act:

- a) Noise should be controlled so as not to disturb neighbouring residents.

In terms of s.142 (g) and (i) of the Act the premises, situated at 10 Tyne Street South Hill Oamaru 9400 are more precisely identified in a plan dated as accepted by the District Licensing Committee on **26 June 2024**.
