MARITZA BOUTIQUE EXHIBITION FREE TOUR SATURDAY 28 May 1.30pm

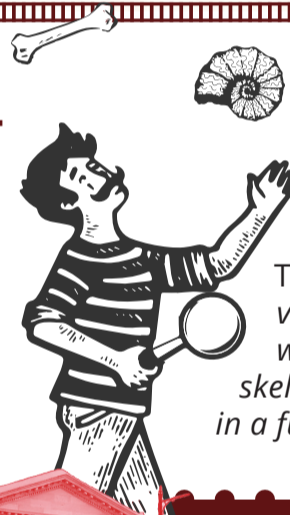
