Timeframe

- 15th of July, Whitestone Contracting will be on-site to commence the trench excavation for the new Events Centre mains cable and transformer.
- 22nd of July, Network Waitaki will be on-site installing the Event Centre transformer and mains cable.
- 15th of July through to the 5th of August, the existing Grandstand will be decommissioned, services disconnected, and the asbestos containing materials removed.
- 5th of August, the Grandstand demolition will be commenced, which will take approximately 7-8 weeks – targeted to be complete by late September.
- 23rd of September Apollo Projects (the design-build contractor) will establish on-site and commence construction of the Event Centre, which is scheduled to be completed by the end of February 2026.
